Rebecca Hopfensperger gave updates to Councillors on various matters, including; the pumping station alarm, that has now been resolved and disarmed, the Animal Feed Mill (Land of Compiegne Way) planning application and it going to DCC on 02.08.23, it has been recommended for refusal, Cllr. Hopfensperger will make a written representation to the DCC panel.

the outdoor gym refused application is going to appeal, Rachel Almond has advised that nothing can move forward until after the appeal has been heard, regarding the

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trees and re-planting, stopping further use of the gym or enforcement regarding the acoustic fending (which is in contravention of the planning refusal). Cllr. Hopfensperger stressed that any noise complaints must be reported, as this will strengthen the case with Environmental Health to get it stopped. Cllr. Hopfensperger confirmed that no permission had been granted for any further trees on the site to be removed! She stressed that any trees being removed etc. should be reported.

23/07/7 Highways/Footpaths & Trees:

i) & ii) Update on Outstanding Highways Issues/Footpaths (Thetford Rd/Parklands Green/Barton Hill to A134) & Trees WSOH

Cllr. Hopfensperger gave the following updates:

- Cllr. Hopfensperger is to chase Mark Walsh regarding works to the footways in Parklands Green. There is no further update on the Manners Road resurfacing, footway surfacing on Barton Hill to A134, the bench repairs at Barton Hill, the gulley works by Flowline on Russell Baron Road, the vegetation cut and signage on the Old Thetford Road footpath.
- The signage on Russell Baron Road has now been replaced.

The Clerk is to compile a list of outstanding and new issues and email Cllr. Hopsfensperger for action and update. The Clerk is to place a notice in the Bugle for volunteers for the PC Self Help Scheme, before the PC has it on the next agenda to consider.

Cllr. Sarah Broughton emailed the following update regarding the dead trees at the WSOH; "Trees on the site have been replaced, but some of these have also died. Drier summers have made the situation difficult and last summer's heatwave put younger trees under some particular stress. The Landscape Supervisor will be surveying the trees against the approved land-scapes plan this summer with a view to re-planting in the autumn".

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iii) Update on Highways Gate

The 'gate' is ordered and delivery is awaited. William Ford, Ford Fencing has been advised.

iv) VAS/SID / Discuss New Batteries Quote / Update on application for an extra post on Barton Hill.

The residents of the dwelling, that the new VAS post is planned to be sited next to have agreed with the installation of the taller post (2.8m), but requested that the post be moved back to the boundary line, when being installed, this has been agreed by the Speed & Safety Team, the post is due to be installed in October 2023.

It was agreed to purchase two lead acid batteries, to replace the batteries in the old VAS Unit, at a cost of £133.50 + VAT (including delivery).

Weekly & Monthly H&S Play Area/Trim Trail Inspection Reports / Agree Rota
No new issues highlighted on reports. Cllr. Borrett (JBo) is to carry on doing the weekly inspections until the next meeting.

ii) Update on Grass Cutting and agree Weed Spraying Quote / Discuss Tree Works in the Playing Field

WSC have now cut the grass, and it can be seen where the trees are hindering access to the grass cutters. Cllr. Borrett (JBo) is to meet on site with tree contractors to get quotes for the works, he will also get a quote to cut back the Oak tree overhanging the Village Sign on the village green. WSC are still to schedule the works to flail the boundaries and to cut back and spray the pernicious weed and brambles.

The Clerk is to place an article in the Bugle reiterating the history of the Traveller encampment and the need for the extra gates and barrier at the playing field, due to some residents and the Church raising concerns, regarding overflow parking for the church.

The Clerk was asked to get a quote to re-treat the bench at the Village Green, once the tree works have been carried out.

Quotes for repair to wooden bus shelter roof

The Clerk presented two quotes for replacing the roof, at a cost of £1,181.00 + VAT (M&TJ's) and £1020.00 Including VAT. The Clerk advised that the boards/cladding on the outside of the shelter will also need replacing before the next winter, at an approximate cost of £1,500.00. It was agreed to defer the item to the next agenda, whilst the Clerk looks at options and funding available to replace the shelter with a new one.

Notice Boards Update +/- Quotes

The Clerk is to go back to the company with the photos and information to seek further guidance or to get quotes for new notice boards.

National Highways - A14 J36 (West of Newmarket) to J43 Bury St Edmunds Meeting
 Traffic management changes

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We are carrying out maintenance and improvement works along the A14 between J36 (West of Newmarket) and J43 (Bury St Edmunds). The work includes the following:

- Improving the road surface eastbound and westbound from J42 to J43 through urban area at Bury St Edmunds. The new road will be quieter than current road surface.
- We need to improve road markings/linings and road studs (cat's eyes) by bringing them up to a consistent standard, between J36 and J43 - required for improved safety on a 4-year cycle.
- We will install new road signs for increased visibility between J42 and 43.
- Upgrading the message signs.

Change of Diversion route;

We are changing the diversion route because:

- The agreed shorter diversion route on the A1302 (through Burys St Edmund) is no longer viable due to the bad road condition (sunken iron works, pavement is poor condition)
- We have been asked by Suffolk Highways to return to the previously agreed diversion route – A134-Thetford – A11

The Chairman advised that he had been contacted by the Church enquiring if any
progress had been made regarding purchase of land for cemetery purposes, once the
current cemetery closes in 10 years. The Clerk advised that as this was only
mentioned at the APM two months ago, no action had yet been taken, as it was not
high on the list of PC priorities. The Clerk clarified the current legislation and process
for 'Closed Churchyards'

Churchyards are classified as either 'Open' or 'Closed' depending on whether they are still 'open' for burials or not. If they have been closed by way of an Order in Council, because the churchyard is full, then the responsibility for the maintenance of the churchyard is usually transferred to the relevant Local Authority, Town or Parish Council. LGA 1972 S215 (2).

The Clerk is to look into the statutory guidance and timeframe for acquiring new land for burials with the Coroners and Burials Division Ministry of Justice.

 The Clerk is to place a notice in the Bugle asking for volunteers to oversee and manage the distribution and delivery of the Bugle newsletter, following the retirement of Peter Foster. The PC offers sincere thanks to Peter for carrying out this role for many years past.
